The tour begins with the archaeological site of Ek Balam, a Mayan archaeological site in Yucatan. It is located to the east of the city of Merida and its name means "black jaguar." The tour then continues to the city of Valladolid. Known as "The Capital of the Eastern Maya," its given title not only for the architectural beauty of its colonial buildings but also for its history. Considered the second most important city in the state of Yucatan, it was founded by Francisco de Montejo in 1543.
