



The archaeological site of Uxmal, surrounded by legends, myths, and anecdotes; poetic in its name and history. It is located in the Santa Elena Valley, next to a series of hills known as the Puuc, which in the Mayan language means "highlands," and that was later the name given to the architectural style of the sites in that region. In this adventure, you can experience swimming in the famous cenotes of the state of Yucatán, natural sinkholes formed in the limestone rock of the Peninsula.
